Established in 1985 as an incorporated foundation of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT).

Structure: Currently a general incorporated foundation (since 2012).

Organization objective: Research, development and provision of a Construction Information System to improve efficiency and quality across the entire construction process.
